what I need from you

What it does for you

The everyday polish on every product page and checkout: the condition note and pickup line under each price, save-% and out-of-stock badges, live cart badges, a guided no-results page, checkout fine print, protection against double-tapped Add to cart, and the stale-notice cleanup that fixed the lost-sale 409 checkout error.

What I need from you

Everything below is something only the store owner can supply or decide — the code side is finished and waiting for these values.

1. Your condition-note and pickup wording

These are promises to customers; the defaults are Empire Tools' wording and should be yours.

Send me the two or three sentences, or set them yourself:

```
wp option update factorize-essentials_options '{"condition_note":"New and unused – packaging may have slight dents...","pickup_title":"Pickup In Store – Free","pickup_sub":"Free local pickup – or flat-rate shipping at checkout."}' --format=json
```

2. Checkout fine print / returns policy text

The fold at checkout shows policy text; I cannot write your legal policy.

One paragraph (all-sales-final, return window, restocking fee...). I place it; you approve the rendered page.

3. Shipping numbers

The pickup line references flat-rate shipping; the rate itself lives in WooCommerce.

Confirm the flat-rate amount and that Local Pickup stays enabled (WooCommerce → Settings → Shipping).

Optional / later

- Per-category condition notes (e.g. different wording for open-box electronics).
- Translations — the plugin is translation-ready; a translator is needed per language.

How you will know it is working

- Open any product: condition note + pickup line under the price, save badge on sale items.
- Tap Add to cart twice quickly on a sold-individually item: no error, one item in cart.
- Search for nonsense: the guided no-results page appears.
